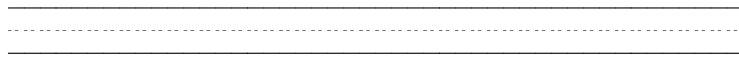




## It is for Horses

Horses weren't the best draft animals for pulling a covered wagon. Horses were not as strong as oxen and got sick more easily. But some pioneers still used horses to pull their wagons. Some pioneers, though not most, had horses to ride alongside their oxen or herd their livestock. Horses could be used to scout ahead for a good camping place. It was much easier to ride a horse than to walk.
